
Friendship Supper Wednesday, April 17, 5pm

I always liked to draw. After high school, I served in the Army in Europe, a great influence on my work.

I attended the University of Tennessee in

Knoxville, majoring in Art, then the Pratt (no relation) Institute in New York City. I was an Art teacher at all school levels --- private, elementary through high school, and college. I was also a graphic artist and product designer.

My wife, Sukey, was on the craft circuit. Being a ceramic artist, she got me started

working in clay.

My paintings are done with acrylic paint on canvas or panel. Ceramic pieces are formed, fired, and finished in acrylic with color changing reflective bits.


I try to create interest and mystery. What inspires me is seeing the work grow from being an idea into something that has potential and consequence.
